**STONETRUST COMMERCIAL INSURANCE EXTENDS ITS SUSPENSION OF ALL POLICY CANCELLATIONS
FOR NON-PAYMENT OF PREMIUM**

Stonetrust Commercial Insurance Company will continue to suspend all policy cancellations for non-payment of premiums from March 15, 2020 through May 31, 2020 due to the mandated business closures and overall business disruption caused by the COVID-19 Pandemic response requirements.

Clients who are unable to pay their workers' compensation premium due to the business disruption caused by current events, will have their premium owed deferred to their next payment invoice after May 31, 2020.

"We want to continue to do our best to help our policyholders get through this terrible event and get back to business. Although each state has issued different cancellation suspension timelines, we will continue to offer our suspension of policy cancellations for any businesses not able to pay their premiums through May 31st. We don't mind adding a few more days to the suspension deadlines issued by each state if it's going to help our policyholders get their businesses operating sooner," says President and Chief Executive Officer, Michael Dileo.

Stonetrust is a commercial insurance company that provides workers' compensation and employers' liability to over 4,500 policyholders.
